Re: Robert Wall - PUBLIC RECORDS REQUEST DENIAL 10/9/2023
REVIEW OF THE EFFECTIVENESS AND SECURITY OF THE DIVISION OF ELECTIONS
IN ADMINISTERING ALASKA'S ELECTIONS (JULY 13, 2020)

Dear Messrs. Flynn and Bell:

As you know, I contacted you in late 2024 and early this year regarding Robert Wall's Public Records Request Denial dated 10/9/2023. The last communication I received was from Mr. Flynn on February 6, 2025, at which point we heard that multiple departments (Office of Governor, Office of Lieutenant Governor, Division of Elections) were re-reviewing the denial. We have heard nothing for the past three (3) months.

Since that time, my client and other Alaskans have formed a nonprofit, Alaskans for Transparent Government (AK Entity #10307885). As of today, I am also representing this nonprofit. To the extent necessary for the State of Alaska's purposes, Mr. Wall cedes his rights regarding any re-review of his records request denial to this new entity. Should the State of Alaska require a request from the new entity, please consider the Public Records Request attached to this letter, which copies Mr. Wall's original request from September 27, 2023.

CONCLUSION AND DEMAND

My clients renew the demand made by Mr. Wall on 12/6/2024 for:

1. A complete and unredacted version of all fact-based information in the Report and accompanying emails, particularly the Table of Contents, Introduction, and Findings sections in the Report.
2. A complete *Vaughn* index with an affidavit from a government employee, explaining the Governor's Office's reasoning for each asserted privilege with particularity.

This offer will remain open seven (7) days. If we do not hear from you by this time, we will conclude that the State does not wish to disclose these public records to the public, and will proceed accordingly.
